

Sanctuary Construction Project Update

Faith Church, Cap-Haitien

March 2018



Faith Church has reached the critical point where their present, primitive sanctuary can no longer accommodate the number of people who want to worship there and to receive its ministries. In order to continue as a beacon of hope to their surrounding community, they must construct a new sanctuary. Approximately 250-300 people worship there on Sundays, many standing outside. New plans have been drawn up to build a large, sturdy, cinderblock sanctuary.

Total Project Cost: US\$10,000

Construction Phases:

1. Foundation framing- completed in 2017
2. Foundation filling- completed in 2017
3. Sanctuary walls- presently making and setting concrete blocks* and wood framing (*in Haiti, concrete blocks are individually made by hand pouring cement into molds)
4. Sanctuary roof- next priority
5. Windows and doors
6. Painting, electricity, floor tile
7. Platform and altar

Present financial need- money for construction materials (sand, gravel, and rebar) and to pay workers. All construction is being done by the men of Faith Church
