Our Core Values

- ❖ **DISCIPLE-MAKING**- Jesus’ Great Commission commands us to “make disciples of all nations.” In obedience to His command and following His example, we will call those whom God draws to us to a committed lifestyle of passionate devotion to Jesus. We will endeavor to entrust our mission to faithful leaders who can lead others into Christian discipleship. (Matthew 28:18-20; 2 Timothy 2:2; Luke 6:40)
- ❖ **SERVANT LEADERSHIP**- we believe God loves everyone. He demonstrated His great love by taking the nature of a servant, suffering death on a cross, and rising from the grave. Through faith in Jesus Christ, we begin the journey of a new relationship with God being transformed by His mercy, love, and power. We will follow His example by serving and loving others with compassion and in practical ways so that everyone might know and experience God’s love. ISA recognizes and affirms the

dignity and equality of each person. We will perform humble, ordinary acts of compassion and service so that we might see the extraordinary emerge.
